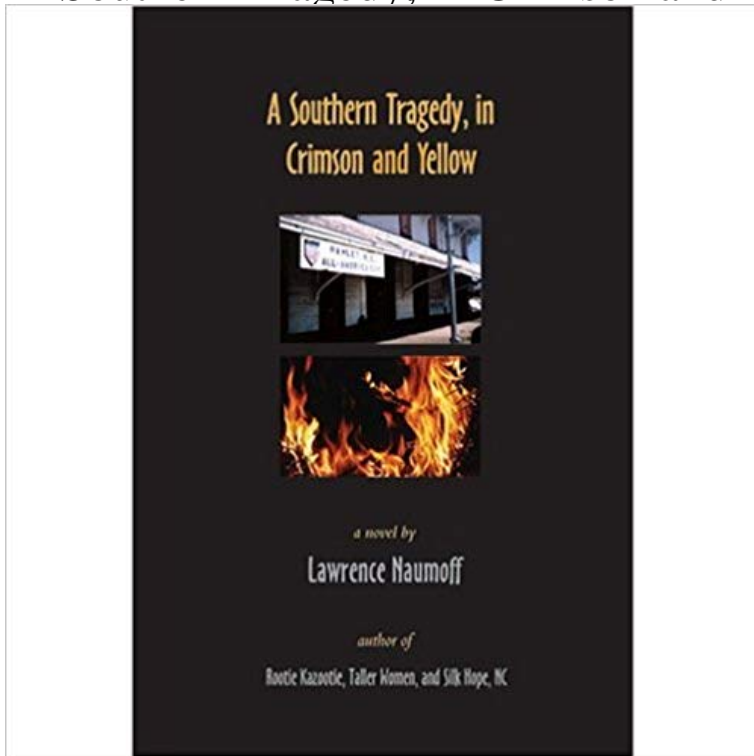


## A Southern Tragedy, In Crimson and Yellow



In 1991, a chicken plant burned in Hamlet, N.C. The fire exits, and most of the other doors had been locked to keep the workers from stealing. This was the worst industrial accident in N.C. history. This book, though a novel, is the story of that fire, the workers, and the town. It is a work of social realism. The book won the Walter Raleigh Award in for the best work of fiction by a NC writer, for the year, 2005. The author has written 6 other books, including Taller Women (A NYTimes Notable Book of the year), Silk Hope, The Longest Mobile Home in the Blue Ridge Mountains, and Rootie Kazootie (Farrar Straus & Giroux). A Southern Tragedy is structured around a family from the merchant class, living in a grand house, starting in 1919, to their, and the towns decline, when, 70 years later, there is no more grand house, no more merchant class, just working chickens. Its told through the women in that family, ending up with Ellie, working in the chicken plant. She leads us to the day of the fire, and what happens as she is trapped inside along with everyone else. This event was covered by nearly all media, even foreign press, and this work is the only book length, literary account of the tragedy and its aftermath. Note: The first 1/3 or more, of the book, is about the history of the town and its families---some reviewers and readers suggested skipping that part of the book if you wanted to read primarily about the fire and its aftermath.
