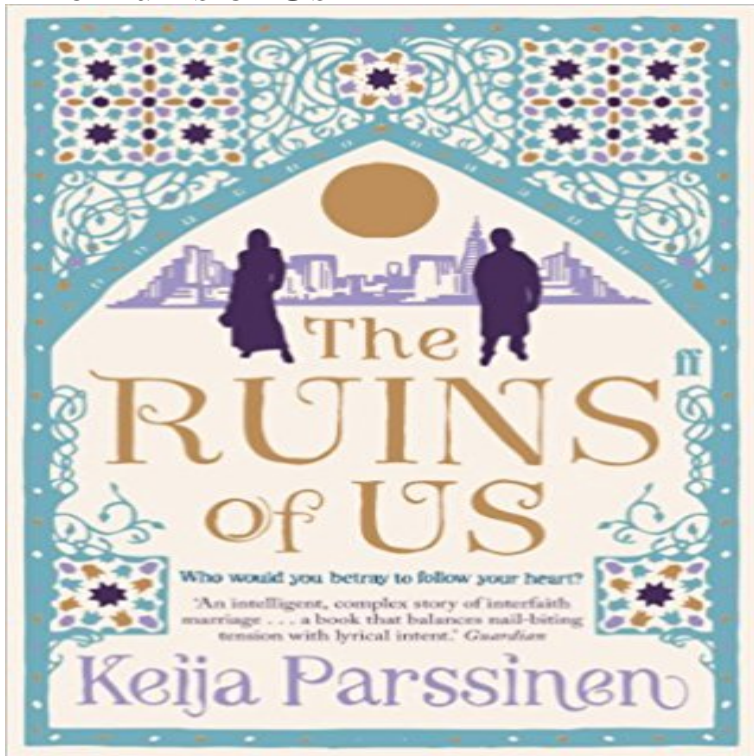


## The Ruins of Us
