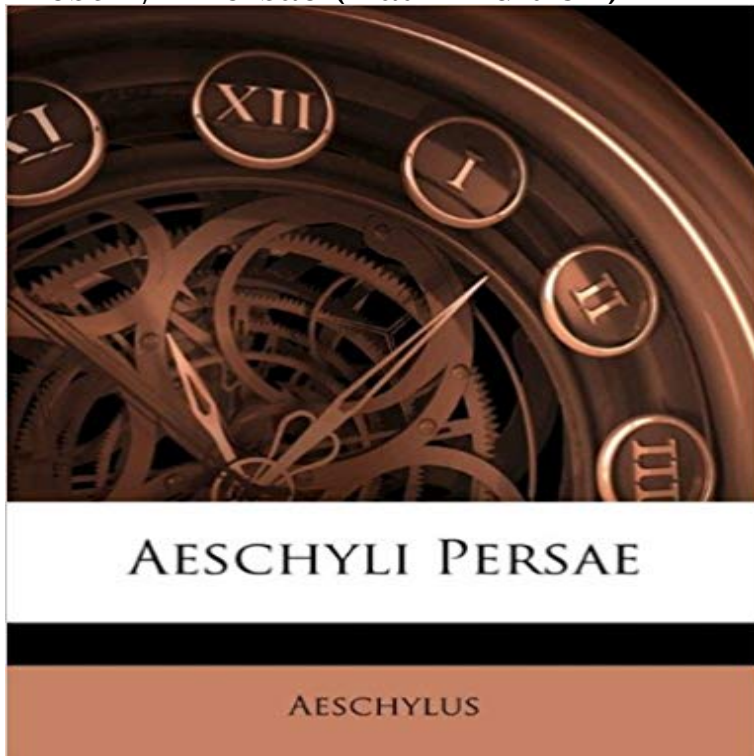


## Aeschyli Persae (Latin Edition)
