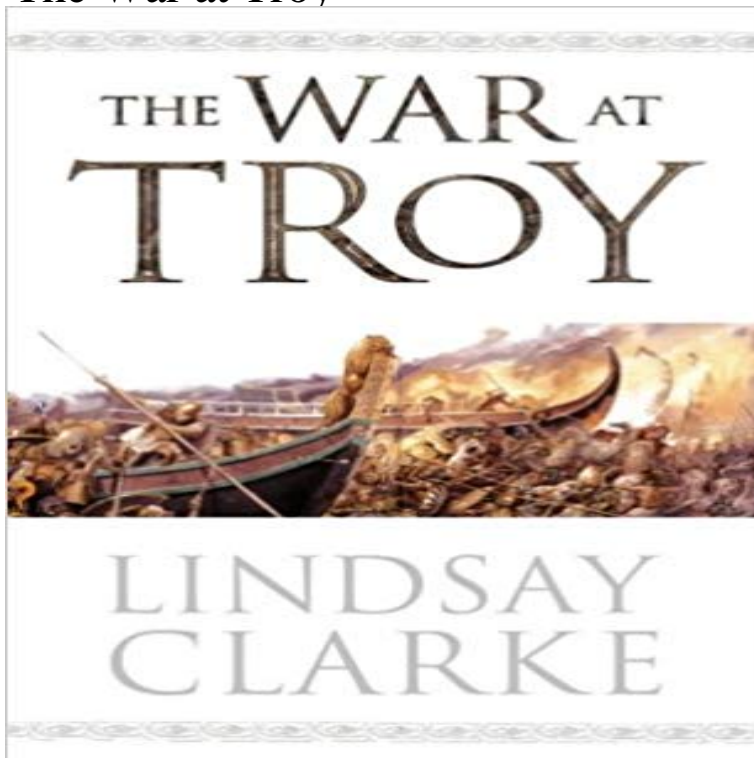


The War at Troy
