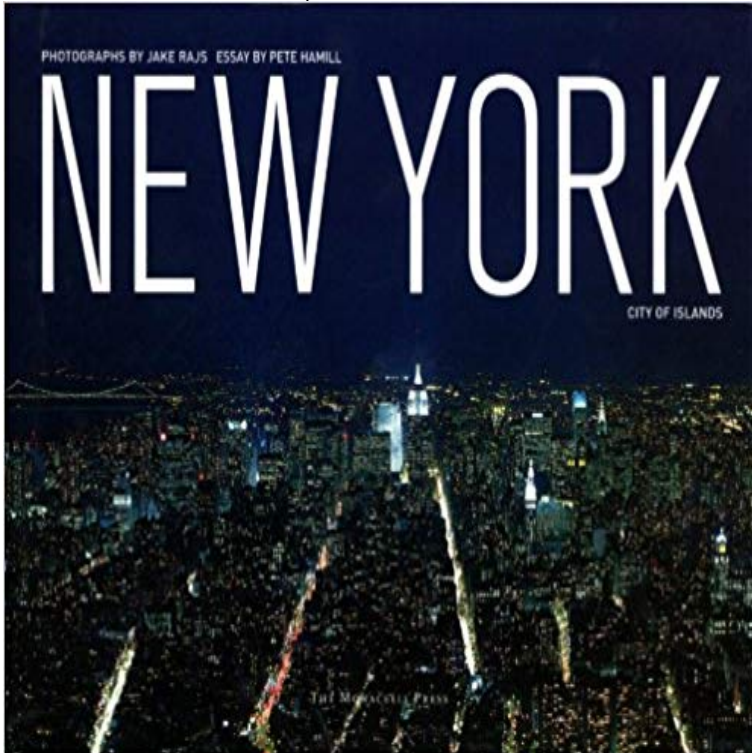


New York: City of Islands
