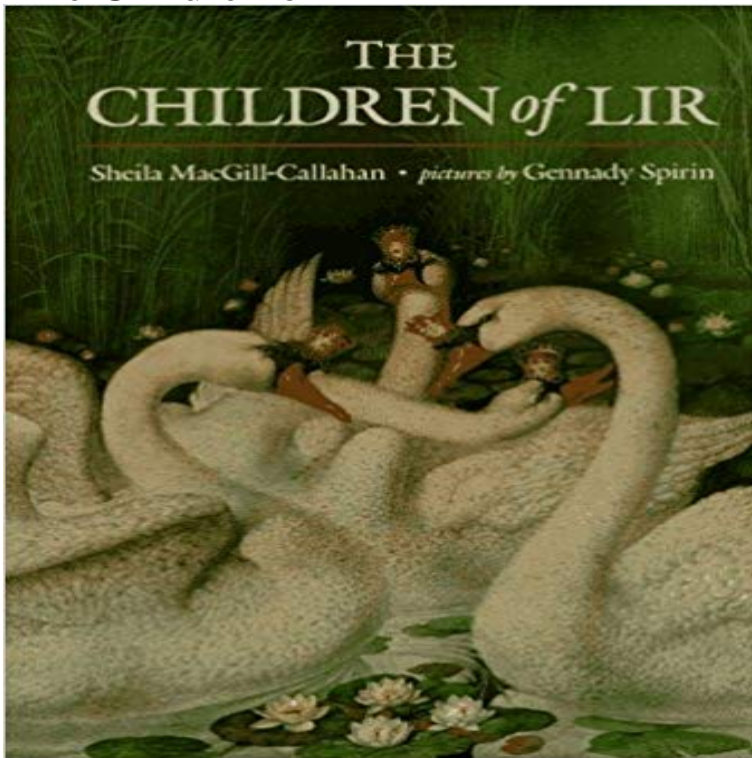


The Children of Lir
