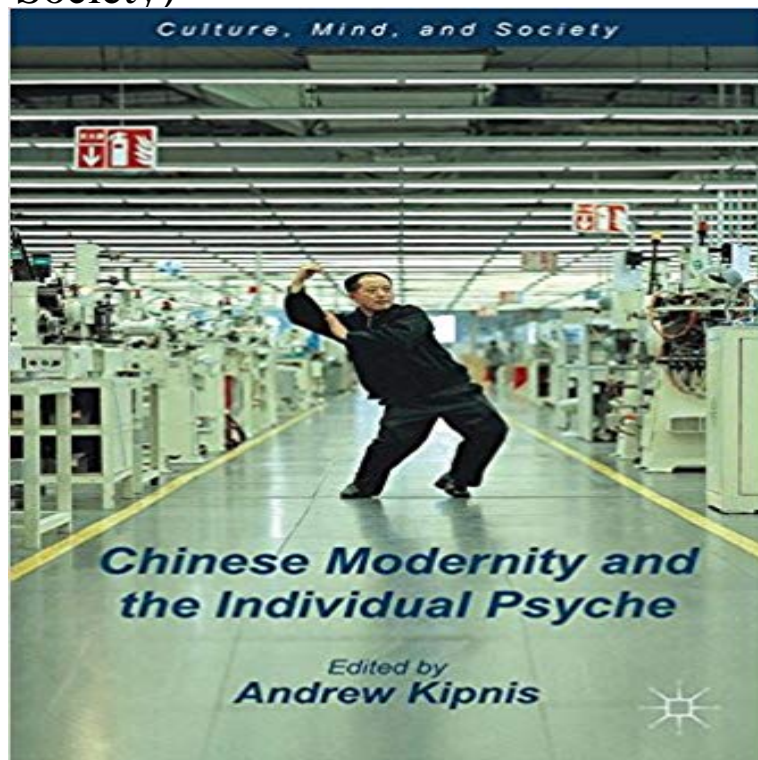


Chinese Modernity and the Individual Psyche (Culture, Mind and Society)
