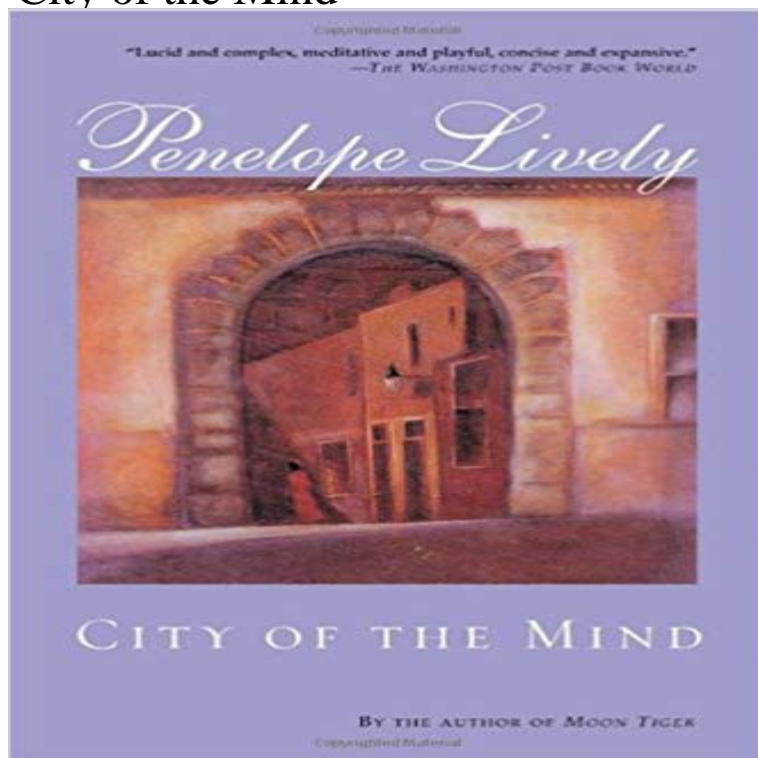


City of the Mind
