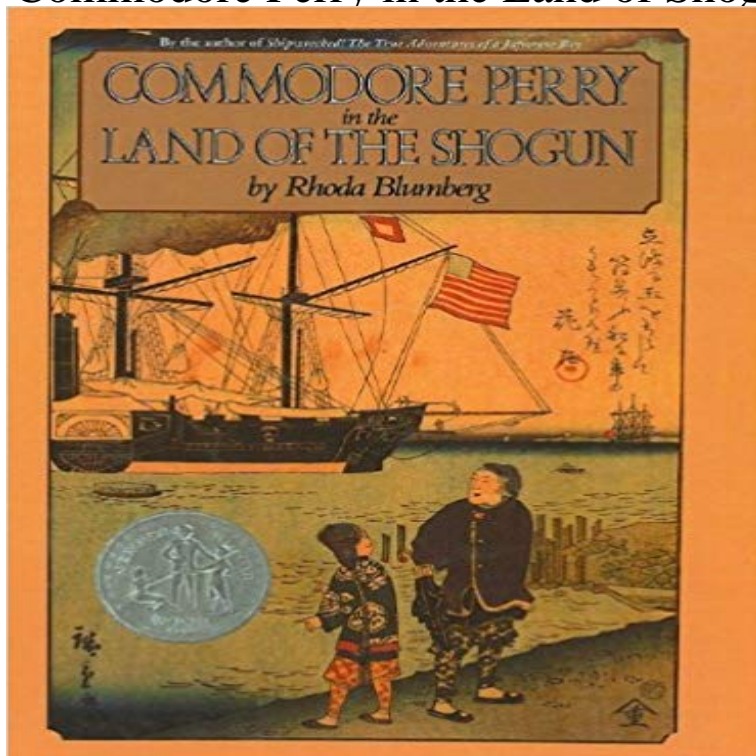


Commodore Perry in the Land of Shogun
