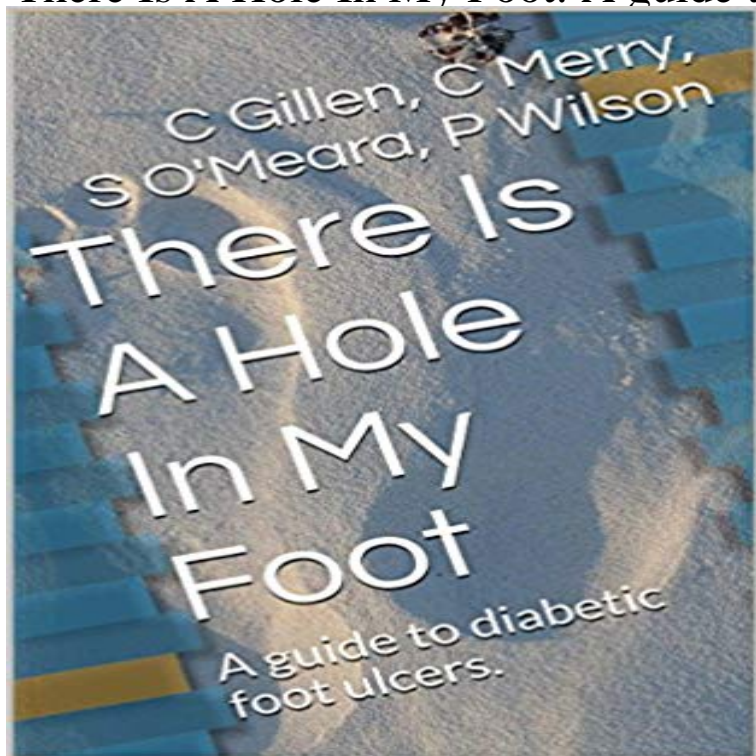


There Is A Hole In My Foot: A guide to diabetic foot ulcers.
