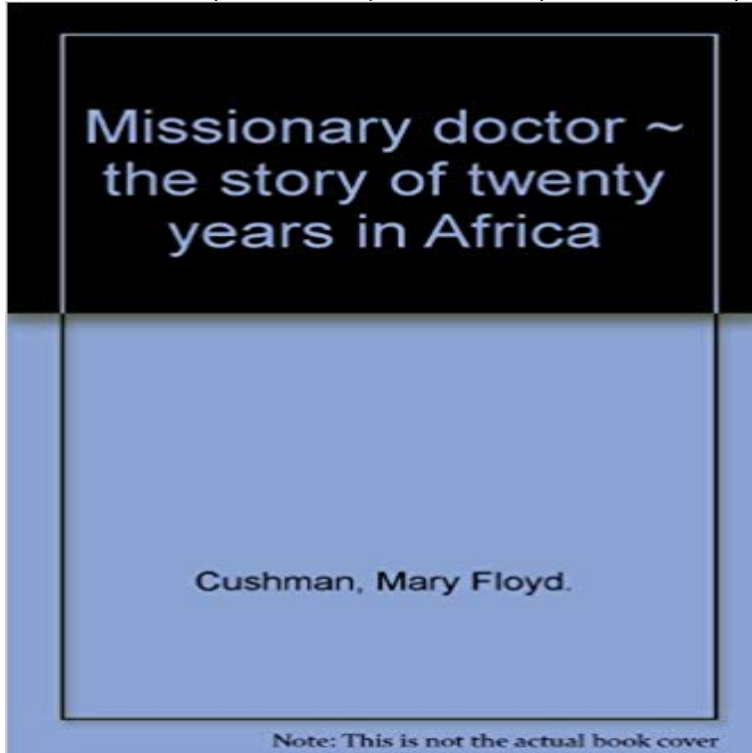


Missionary doctor, the story of twenty years in Africa,
