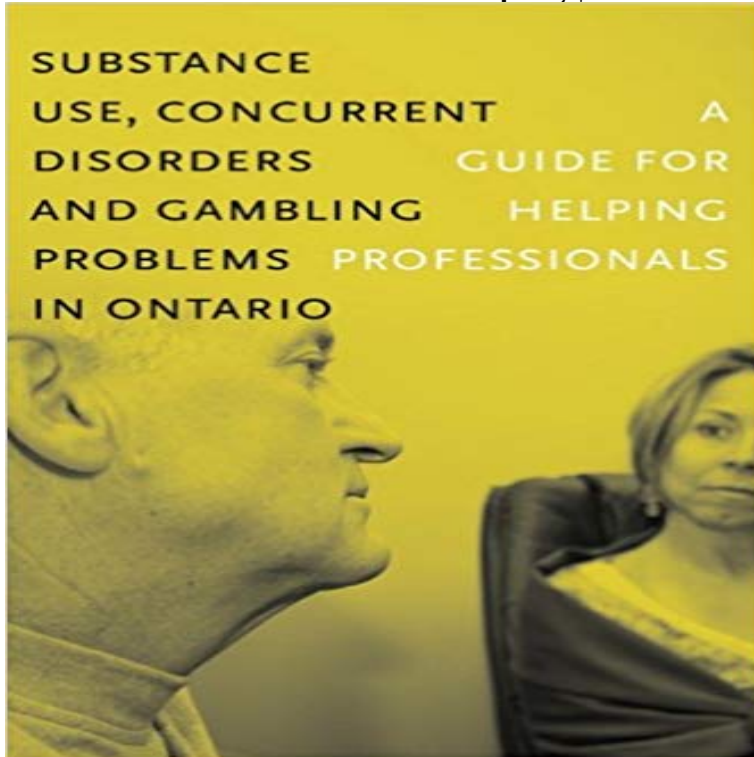


# Substance Use, Concurrent Disorders, and Gambling Problems in Ontario: A Guide for Helping Professionals
