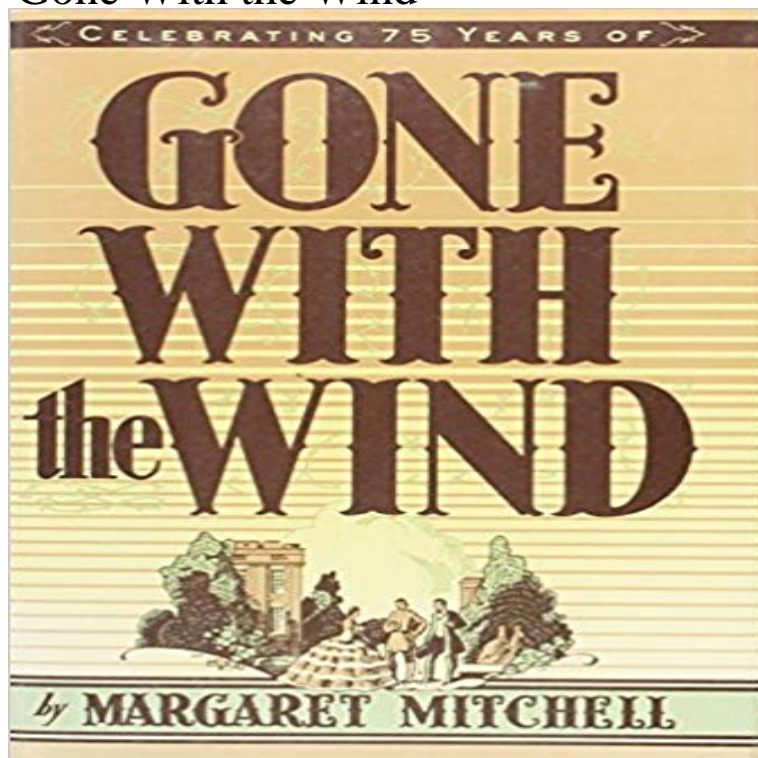


Gone With the Wind
