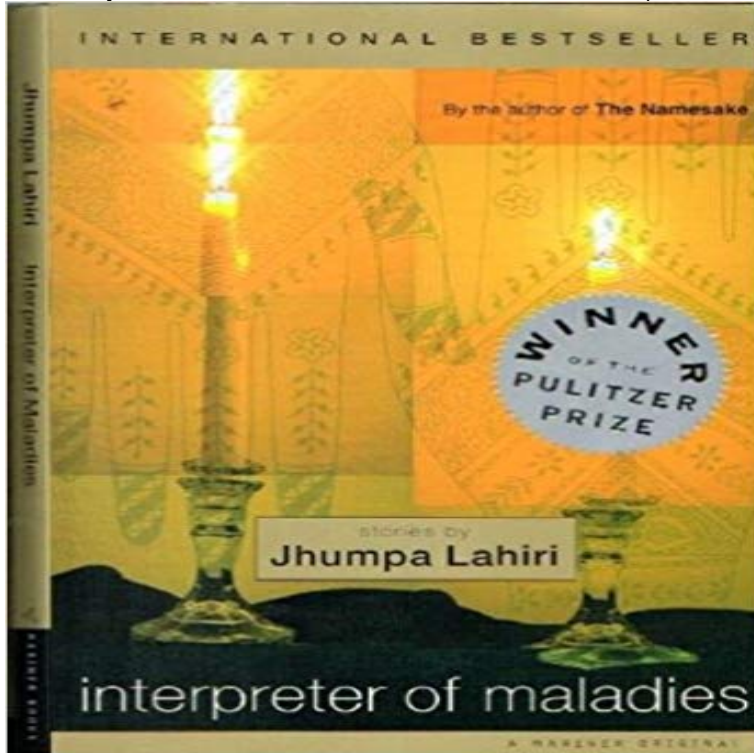


Interpreter of Maladies Stories by Jhumpa Lahiri
