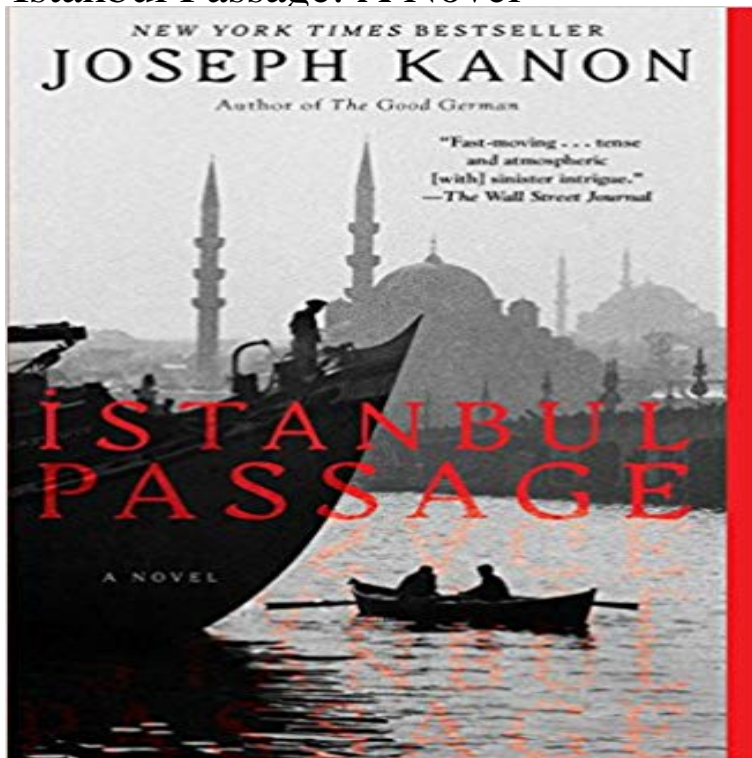


Istanbul Passage: A Novel
