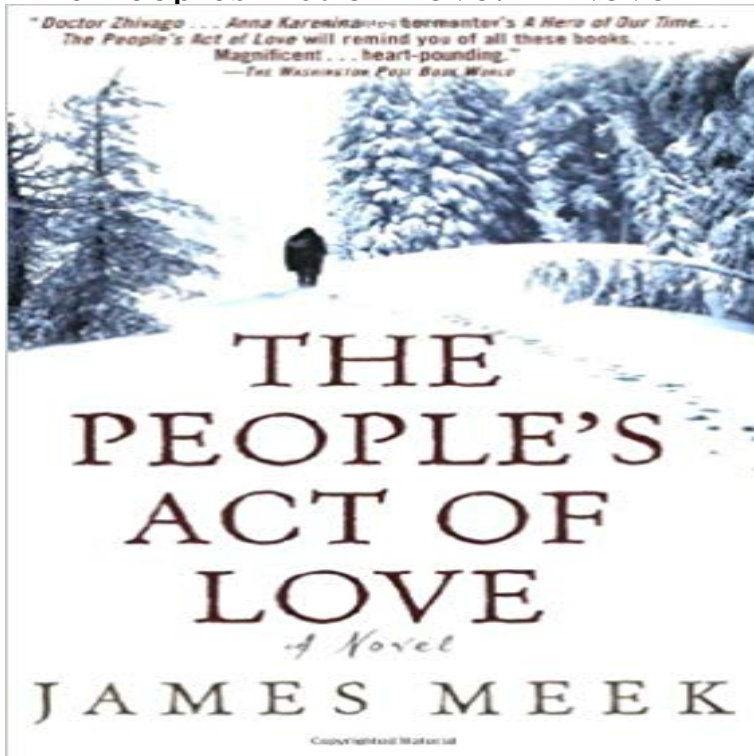


The Peoples Act of Love: A Novel
