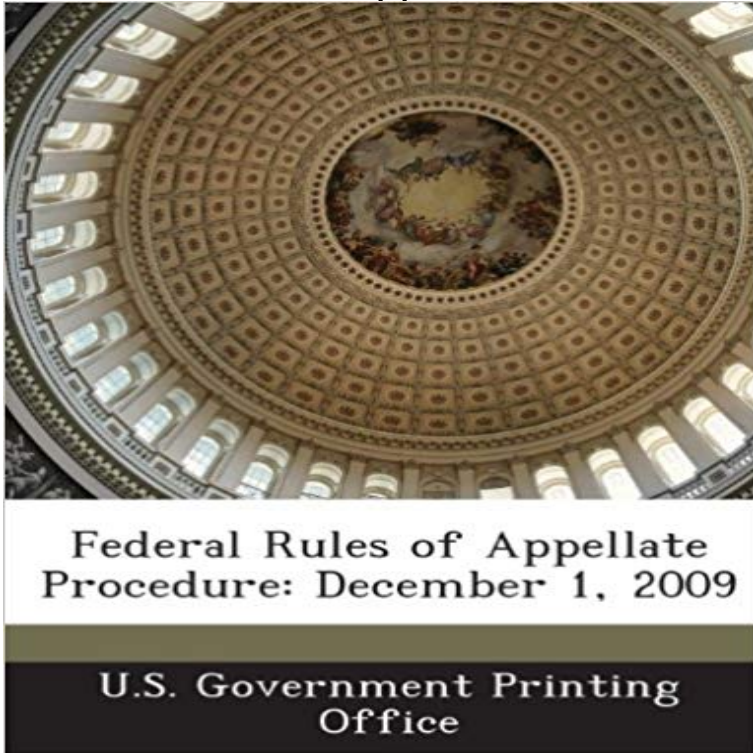


Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure: December 1, 2009
