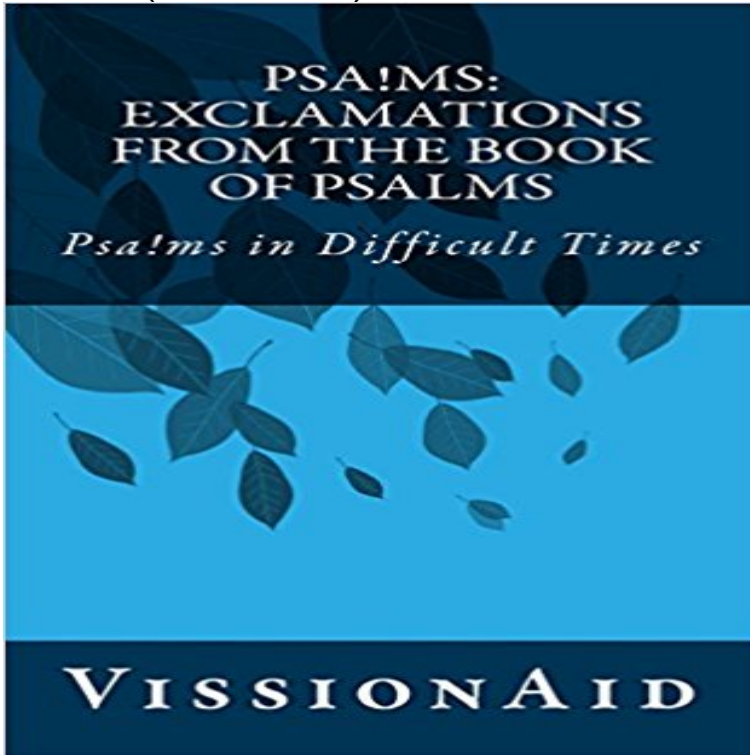


Psa!ms: Exclamations from the Book of Psalms: Psa!ms in Difficult Times (Volume 1)
