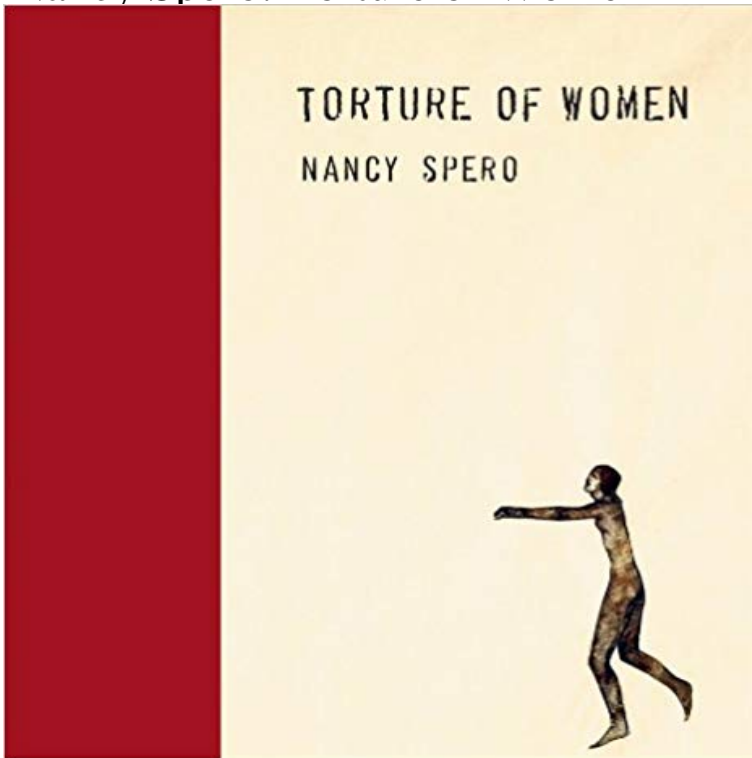


Nancy Spero: Torture of Women
