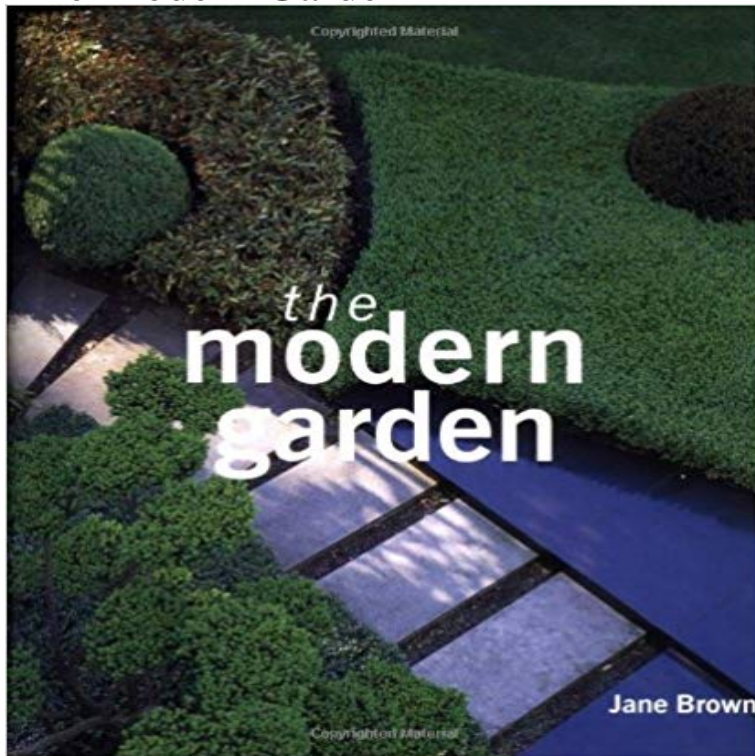


The Modern Garden
