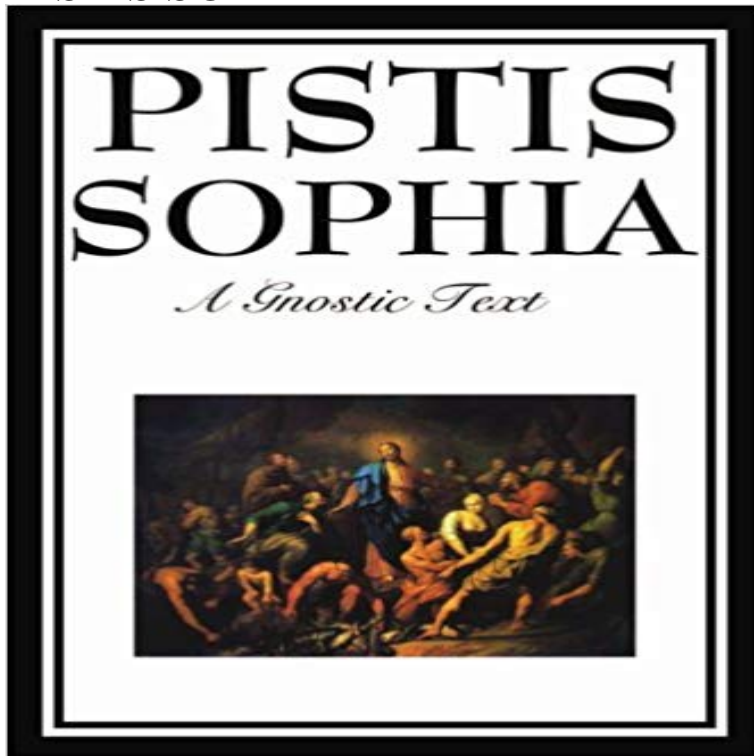


PISTIS SOPHIA
