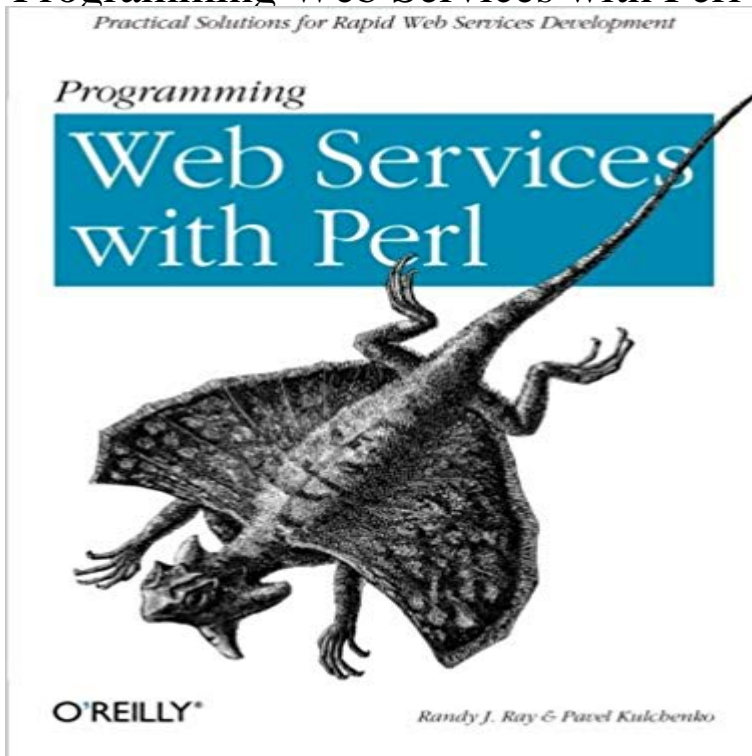


Programming Web Services with Perl
