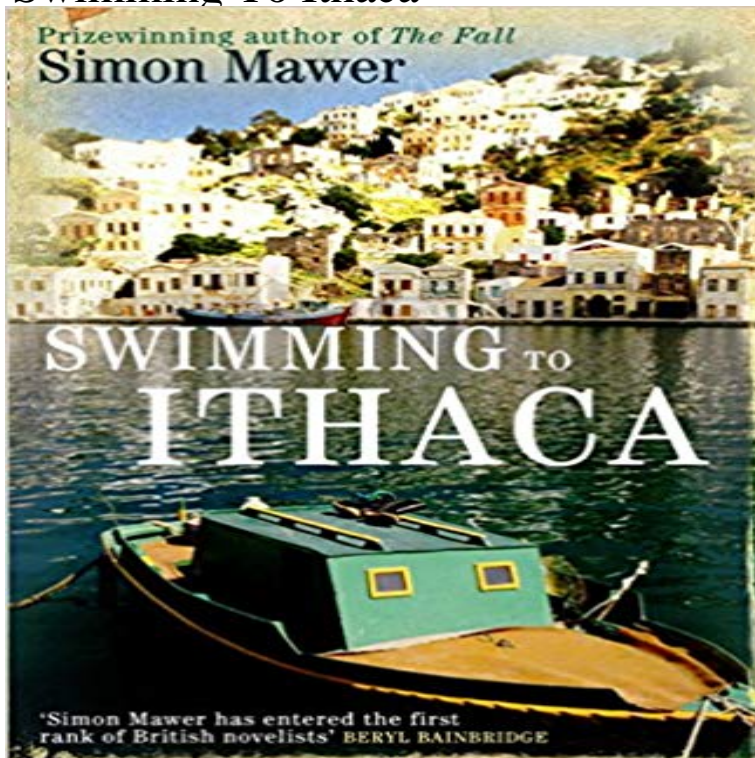


Swimming To Ithaca
