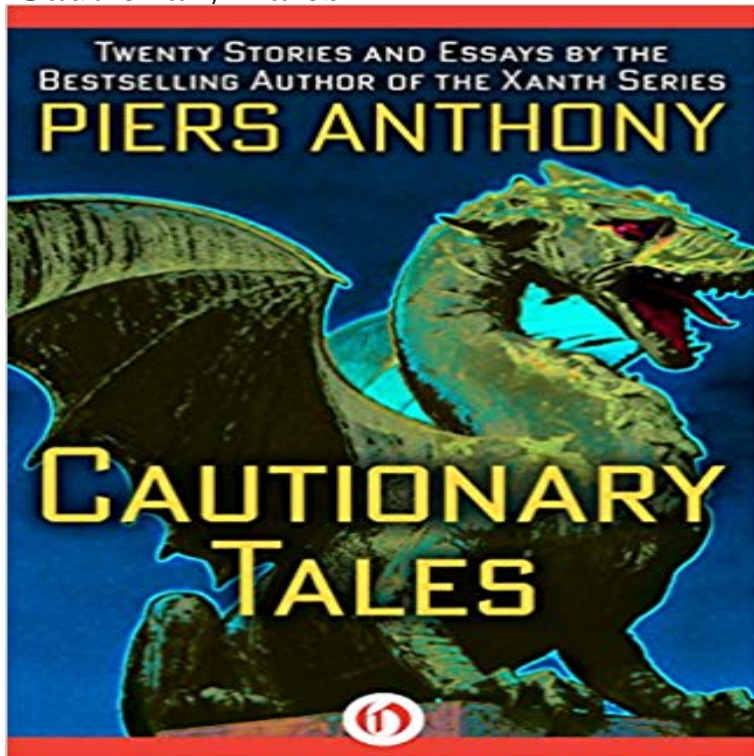


Cautionary Tales
