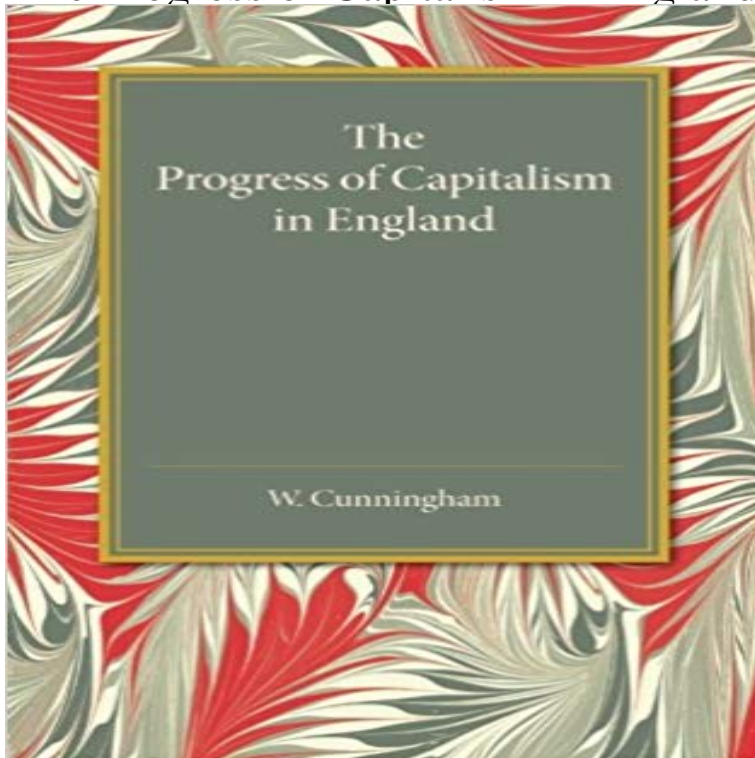


## The Progress of Capitalism in England
