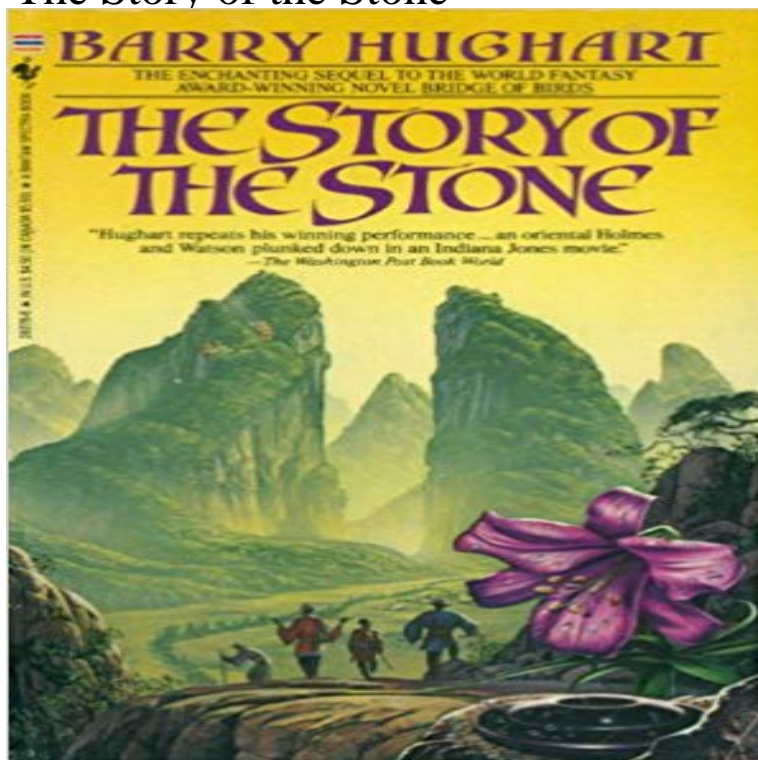


The Story of the Stone
