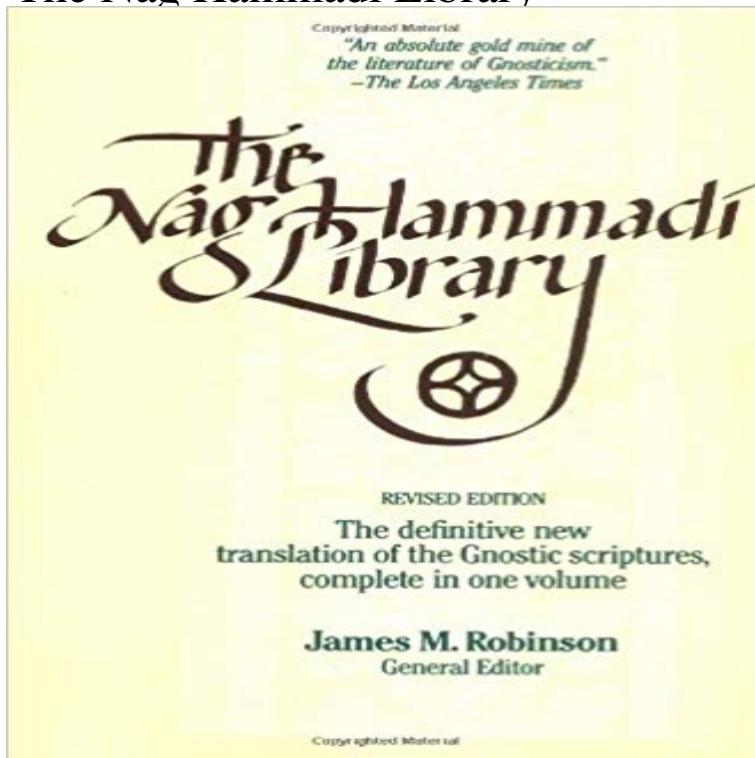


## The Nag Hammadi Library
