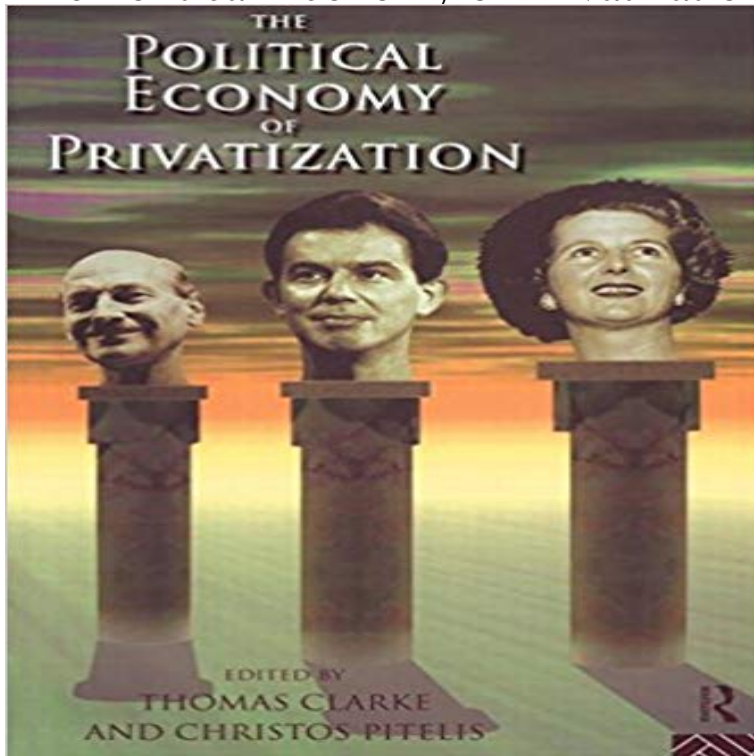


The Political Economy of Privatization
