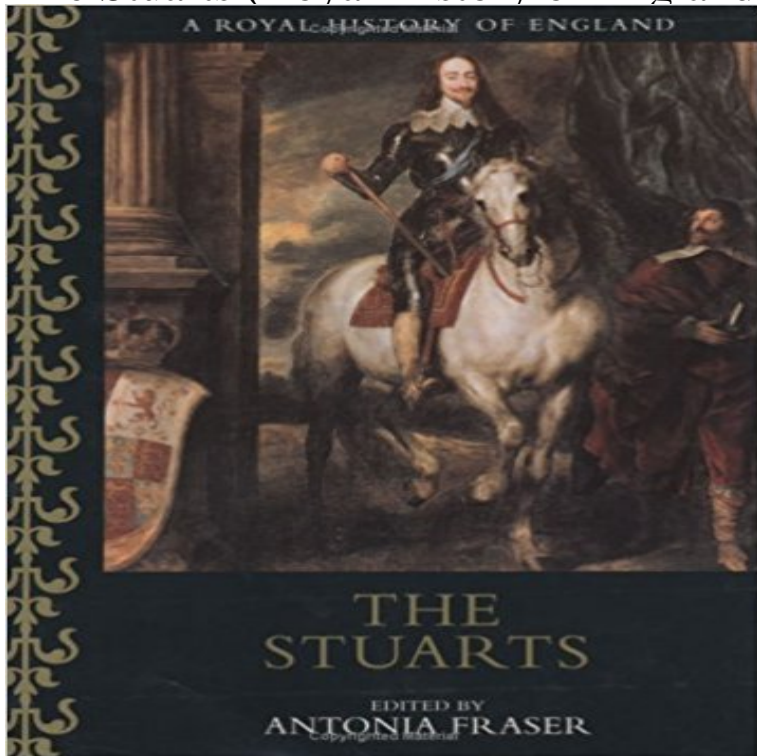


# The Stuarts (Royal History of England)
