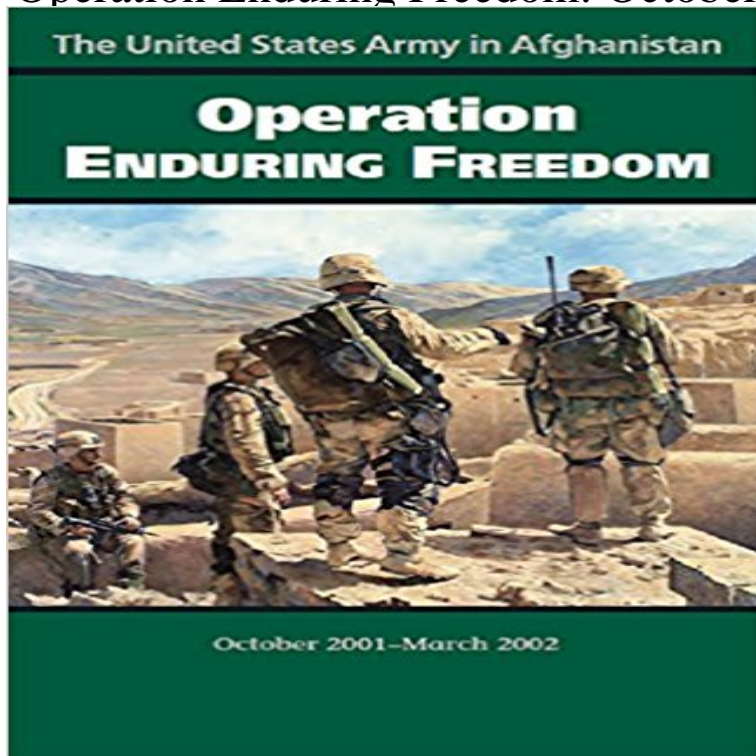


Operation Enduring Freedom: October 2001-March 2002:
