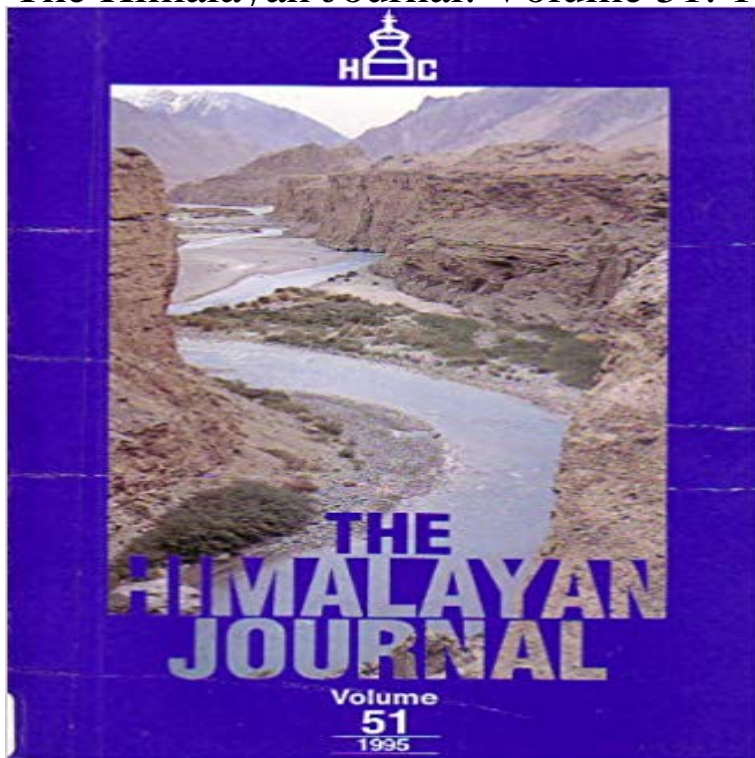


The Himalayan Journal: Volume 51: 1995 (v. 51)
