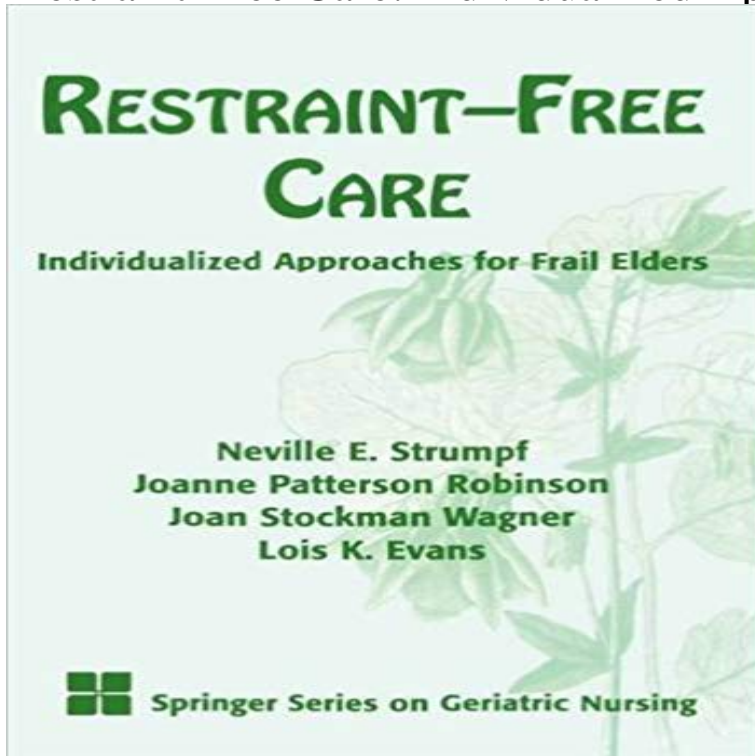


Restraint-Free Care: Individualized Approaches for Frail Elders
